Sensing the Education Future (SEF) is all about bringing to light the everyday, yet important, conversations that occur in schools, universities, TAFEs, communities and other workplaces in the education sector, throughout Western Australia!

The goal is to create useful insights that can help us to explore and understand key issues in the WA education system; and new ways of addressing these issues together, as an education community.

Fogarty EDfutures have teamed up with Cognitive Edge to bring this story collecting method, which is based on twenty years of research and experience, to Western Australia. We want to open this project up as much as possible as a way of bringing individuals, organisations, communities, and government together to understand what is going on in the education sector: what is going well, what not so well, and what matters most in education.

We will share the results of this project with YOU, the education community in WA, and there will be follow up events where individuals and groups can come together to discuss what happens next? The idea is that through collecting and sharing stories, communities are able to develop local solutions to local problems, and help influence government decisions by asking "How do we create more positive stories like this, and less negative ones like that?"
